How to use

This action has been tested and working on Photoshop (English version only) CS6,CC+

If you are not using the English version of Photoshop, you can always change it to English and then back again to your native language.

HOW TO INSTALL THE ACTION

1. Inside Photoshop, go to the 'Window' menu and select 'Actions'. A window will now appear to the right hand side.
2. Inside the Actions window, click on the top right hand corner icon to reveal the drop down menu. From here select 'Load Actions...'. Select the action which came with the download.
3. The action will now appear in the actions panel.

HOW TO INSTALL THE BRUSHES

1. Inside Photoshop, go to the 'Window' menu and select 'Brush Presets'. A window will now appear to the right hand side.
2. Inside the Brush Presets window, click on the top right hand corner icon to reveal the drop down menu. From here select 'Load Brushes...'. Select the Brush which came with the download.
3. The Brush will now appear in the Brush panel.



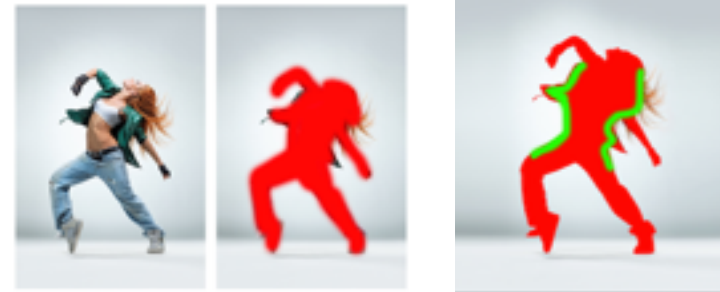
Please check:

1. Your photo is in RGB color mode
2. Your photo is in 8bit color mode
3. You are running the English version of Photoshop.
4. Image has resolution in range from 3000px to 4500 px.
5. Before you play action be sure that your main image reset to background with lock.

If your image have a difference name like as layer 0, select them and go to Layer->New->Background from layer. You will see your layer with name `Background` with lock. Or you can select all layers and make flatten image.

HOW TO USE THE ACTION

1. Open your image
2. Create a new layer with name `mask` (without caps and commas)
3. Select a hard brush with opacity 100% and draw mask
4. Create a new layer with name `brush` (without caps and commas)
5. Select a soft brush with opacity 100% and draw lines where you want to place effect
6. Select direction of fire from Action panel
7. Press play the Action
8. See the video how to edit layers
- 10.If you want add animation, go to action panel and select 'Add Animation'
- 11.Press play the Action
- 12.Save the result as static or gif (For gif animation go to `File->Export->Save for web`. Select the gif format and set Looping option to Forever)
