

Adobe Photoshop ActionScript

Installation and Use



1. Install The Actionscript and Patterns

Copy and Place “Editorial Mixed Media FX.jsx” into your Photoshop Scripts Folder which is usually located:


on Pc C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe Photoshop\Presets\Scripts
on Mac Applications\Adobe Photoshop\Presets\Scripts



Install “Editorial Mixed Media Patterns.pat” with a double-click on the icon
or manually Load them from Photoshop under Edit > Presets > Preset Manager

Check the Patterns Opacity and Mode

Click G on your Keyboard then Switch to "Patterns" in the top dropdown menu and check that they're set to 100% and Normal






2. Open your Image
can be a text, a drawing, everything

3. Create a New Layer and paint an area using your favourite Tool(s)

It's very important that this Layer is Selected in the Layers Palette before you Play the Script and your image behind (*Background*) must be visible like in this screenshot.

4. Go to File > Scripts and choose Editorial Mixed Media FX

Remember that we have to place them in the Scripts Folder they will also appear available under File > Scripts (step1)



5. Fully Layered and Grouped final Document

Editorial Mixed Media ActionScripts are non-destructive: the original photo and the Starting Selection are intact, so you can do all your changes and create an amazing artwork or delete and start over.

6. The Group “White Strokes”

Often times we need to apply a Layer Mask to the White Strokes (bright parts) generated by the ActionScript.

Depending on the photo you might need to even remove this Group or Duplicate it: every photo will need your judgment and taste to really look polished.

and download the FX Box. Watch the quick video tutorial to easily install it.

Once installed we can find it under Window > Extensions > FX Box.
Remember to restart Photoshop if it was open.








Click on the Plus Icon

After you click on the Plus Icon navigate to this Folder and Select Editorial-Mixed-Media-FX_installer.jsx






- Open Your Photo
- Draw the Starting Selection
- Click Apply

Create a New Layer and Paint the Area where you want the Effect applied.

With the photo visible, and this Layer selected
Click "Apply this Effect"




