

How to configure Photoshop to work with action

- **Make sure graphics processor acceleration enabled !**

Go to Photoshop or Edit -> Preferences -> Performance and verify that "Use Graphics Processor" is enabled.

- **Make sure you are using the English version of Photoshop.**

- **Use the RGB Mode and 8 Bits color.**

To check these settings, go to Image->Mode and check the "RGB color" and "8 Bits/Channel".

- **Make sure that the option "Add 'copy' to Copied Layers and Groups" and "Use Default Masks on Fill Layers" is turned on.**

On the "LAYERS" panel, click on the menu icon, go to "Panel Options..."

and check that the "Add 'copy' to Copied Layers and Groups" is turned on. "Use Default Masks on Fill Layers" is turned on.

Image resolution

- **For the best results, it is recommended to use photos in the range of 800px - 3000px.**

- **In order to get correct design scale**

Play "2000 px +" action for 2000-3000 pixel photos.

Play "1000 px +" action for 800-1800 pixel photos.

- **Change image size.**

Go to Image->Image Size and change width or height to 2000 px. Resample checkbox - **ON**.

How to install the action

1. Double click on "Twitch Glitch Action.atn" file to load it inside Photoshop CC.

How to use the action

1. Open your image and be sure it has right size; (Image - Image Size)
2. Be sure your photo layer is set as the "Background" locked layer; (Layer - New - Background from Layer)
3. Create a new layer and name it "AREA" (uppercase letters)
4. Paint on the layer the area that you need to focus. Use Pen Tool (P) in "shape" mode to make perfect area masks.
5. Click play on action selected in action panel. (Window - Actions)
6. After action finished, choose one of the twenty color presets.
7. Paint with soft brush (Flow: 10% - 40%) on "Reveal Layer" mask to bring back original details on the photo.

Only 2 layers before action play
